

VERDICT ON JEE & NEET

The Union Government explained that that the national eligibility cum entrance test (NEET) and the Joint Entrance examination will occur as scheduled in September and there is no returning for medical and engineering entrance test. The explanation goes ahead a day that observed a great deal of noise, virtual protest and even a proper appeal to the Prime Minister Narendra Modi by BJP parliamentarian Subramanian Society.
