


The students of Sai Balaji Education Society celebrated Gandhi Jayanti with lot of enthusiasm creativity and with holiness.

Such activities helps to grow Human, Social and Family values among the youth. Which reflects in change of their behaviour and thought process towards elderly people.





15th August 2018


