The students of Sai Balaji Education Society celebrated Gandhi Jayanti with lot of enthusiasm creativity and with holiness.

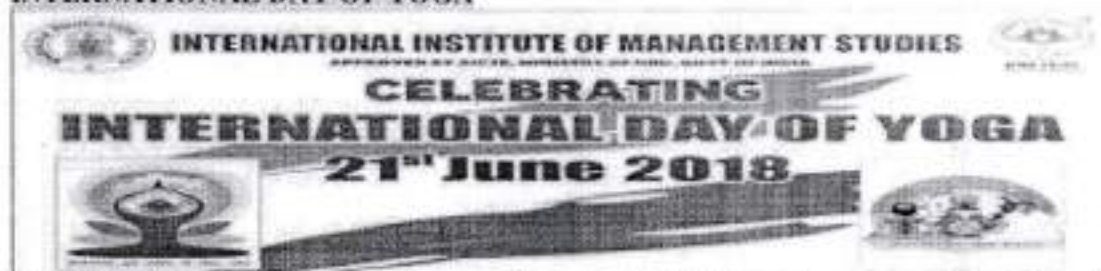
We first prayed to our great freedom fighter Gandhi ji after that our rangoli specialists girl power started with their beautiful colourful rangoli's and after this we started with our today's



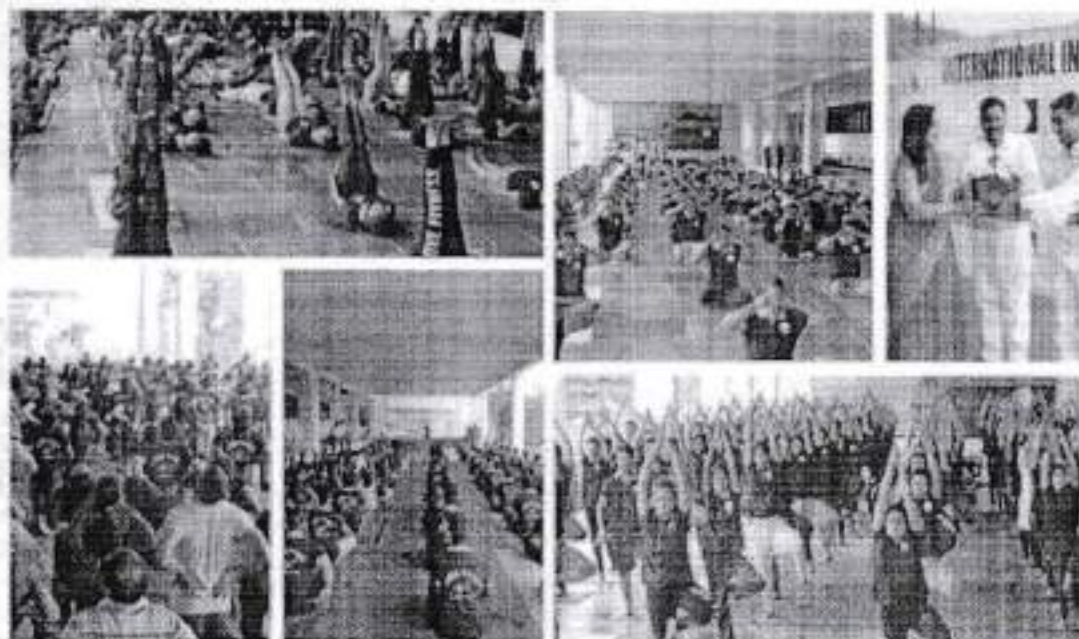
initiative that was started on this day by our Prime Minister Narendra Modi Ji in the honour of our beloved Gandhi ji.

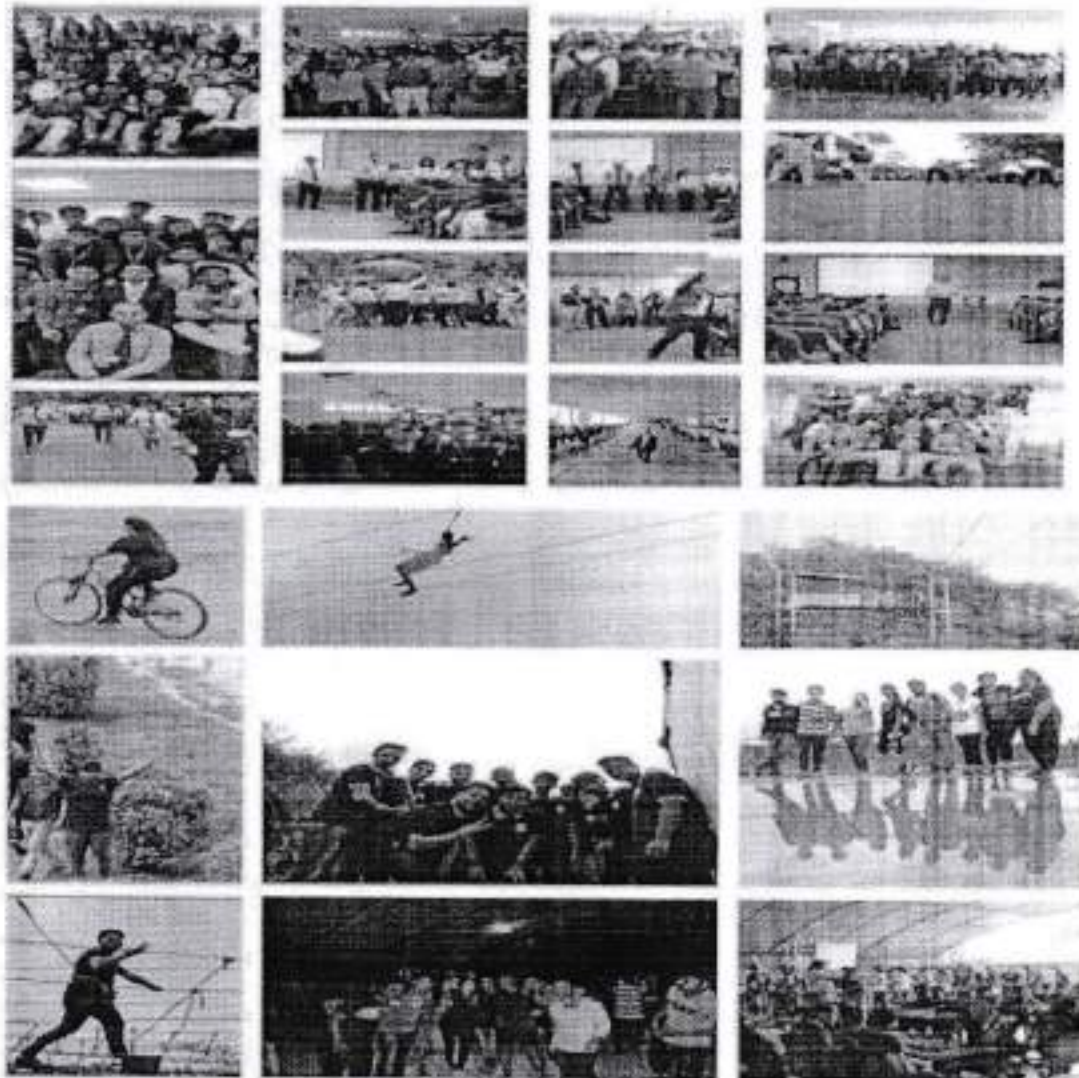


FINISHING SCHOOL & OUTBOUND PROGRAM

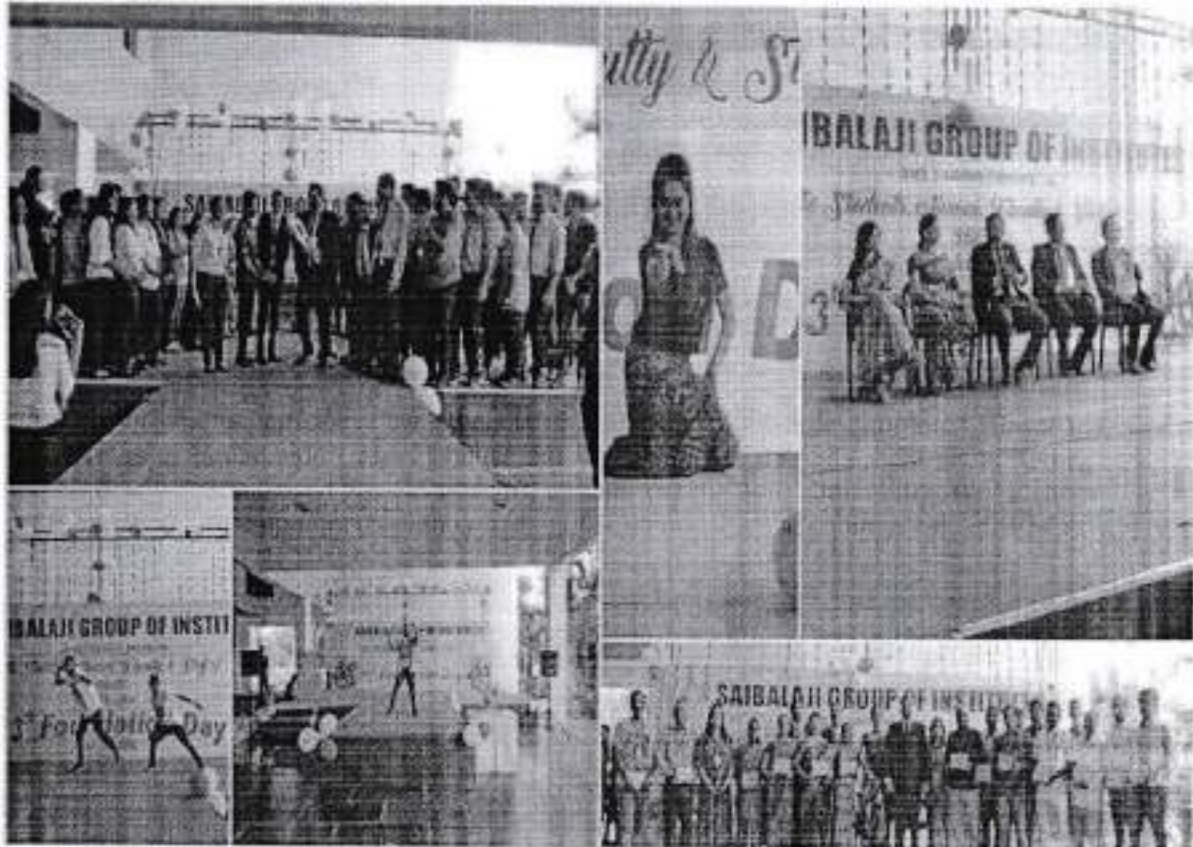
FOUNDATION DAY

NATIONAL YOUTH DAY



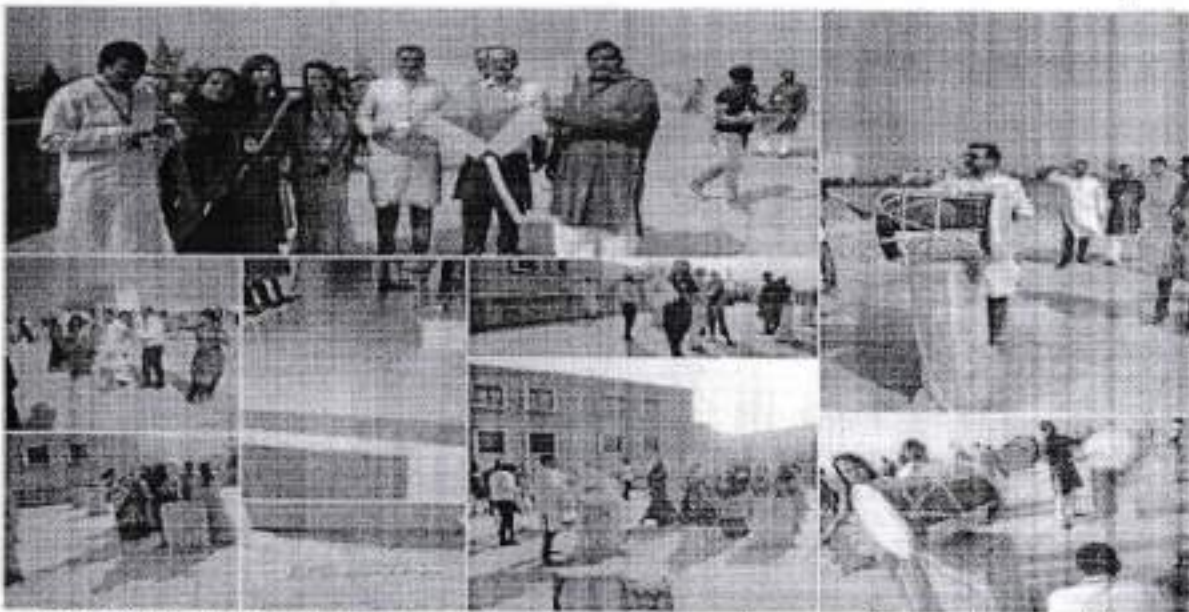

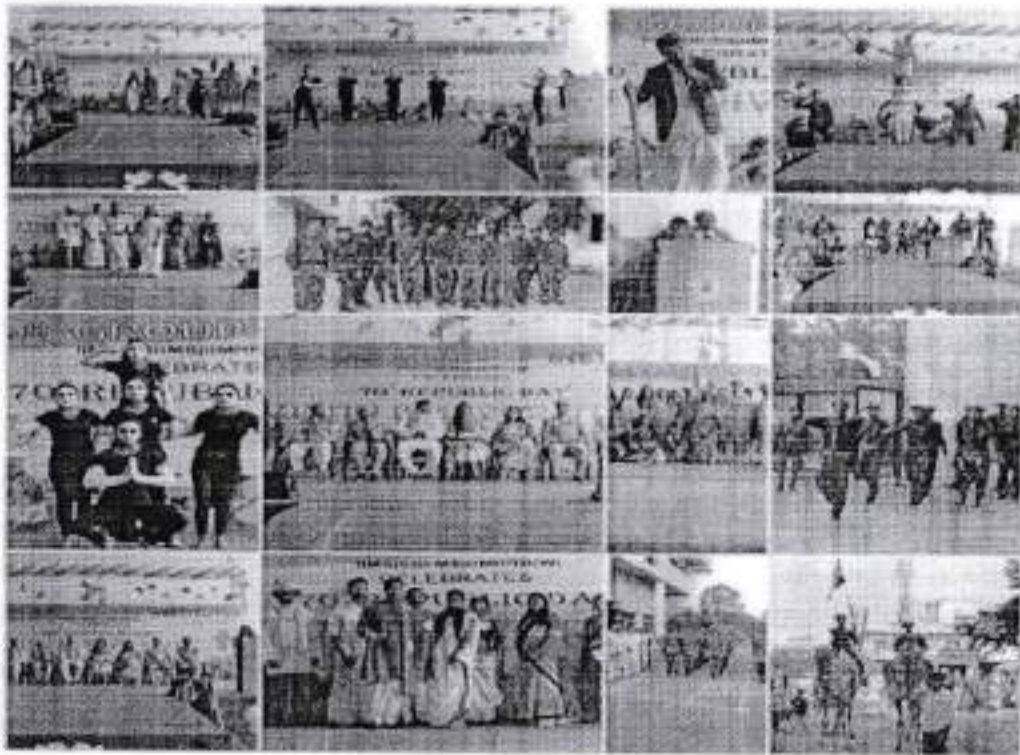

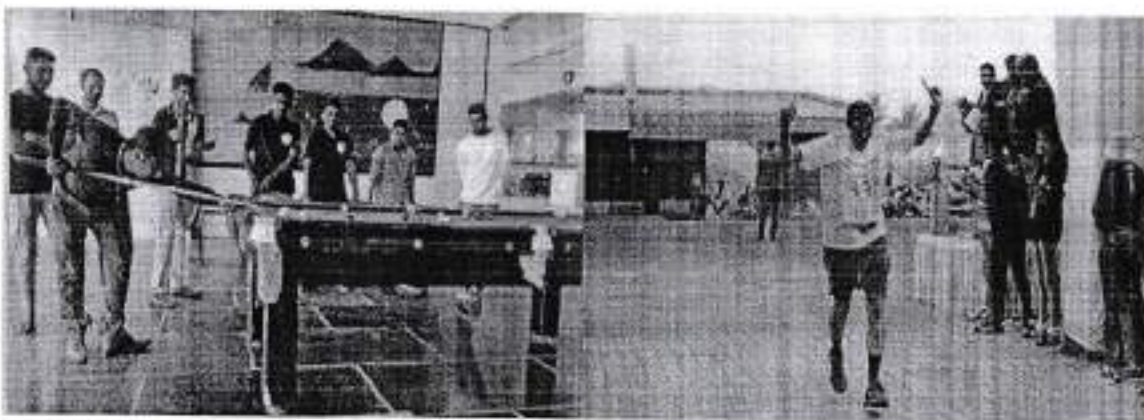




SPORTS
